Things to Note (Answers to FAQ's)

This is our second year at SugarPine, there are some things that need to be revisted and noted before arriving:

- The accommodations for deluxe were indicated as including linens. After having further
 discussions with Sugar Pine, they are only providing linens for the one double bed in the cabin,
 all other bunks(twin beds) will not have bedding. We are telling you to <u>bring your own bedding</u>,
 sheets, sleeping bag, pillow or whatever you require to sleep on a twin bed. Also, you must
 bring your own towels.
- 2. You may want to bring a lawn chair for sitting outside or watching sports and events.
- 3. Weather and altitude is very similar to Hartland. In other words, the day time can be warm(mid to upper 80's) and the mornings will be cool(50's). Bring appropriate clothing.
- 4. Regarding clothing, modesty is the guideline. Girls should not have tops that show the stomach, no cleavage, no bare midriffs, and shorts must be mid thigh. We aren't the clothing police and leave that up to the individual churches. Please follow the rules and please let your campers know.
- 5. Swimsuits- One piece only or shirt over two piece. Must have cover ups to walk to and from swimming pool.
- 6. For evening services, no shorts. So males bring your pants and females bring your pants/dresses or appropriate clothing for evening chapel services. Come prepared and ready to stay for evening services. Bring your Bible. No flashlights. There will be no beverages allowed in service. Please take care of your bathroom breaks before.
- 7. \$\$ There is a snack bar at camp. There are additional recreation activities that are available but cost extra. Ropes Course:\$15 per person. Zip Line: \$10 per person. Paintball: \$15 per person.
- 8. There will be no train ride this year.
- 9. The first event at Sugar Pine is lunch at 12:30 on Tuesday. We leave Saturday morning after breakfast and cleanup.
- 10. There will be a camp picture available for purchase. Cost is \$5.00.
- 11. You must go to Morning Services, Classes and Evening Services.
- 12. Camp is for spiritual uplifting, worship, fun and rest. Put your Christian walk into practice!
- 13. See separate list for other things to bring.
- 14. We discourage personal electronics. Especially music and video that doesn't honor God.
- 15. There will be a curfew. Lights out and quiet at that time.
- 16. All those under 18 must have a completed and signed Emergency Information and Release Form. (Forms available on website www.flmbcvisalia.org)
- 17. All campers must have a completed and signed SugarPine Waiver and Indemnity Agreement.
