What should I bring to camp?

Necessary Items:

- 1. Bible
- 2. Notebook & Pen
- 3. Sleeping Bag/Bedding for twin bed
- 4. Pillow
- 5. 2 or more towels
- 6. Washcloth, Soap, Shampoo, Hairbrush
- 7. Toothbrush, Toothpaste AND Deoderant
- 8. 2 pairs of shoes
- 9. 5 or more pairs of underwear and socks
- 10. Appropriate shorts. Must cover everything and should be appropriate
- 11. Shirts (no inappropriate logos & no bellies & no bra straps)
- 12. Pants for night services(3-5)
- 13. Money for offering, snack, camp picture, activities.
- 14. Bug Spray.
- 15. Sweatshirt or light jacket.
- 16. Decent bathing suit & Cover Up.
- 17. Flashlight(optional)
- 18. Plastic Bag for dirty clothes.
- 19. Your medicine if needed and make sure you have a completed signed Medical Form for all under 18 and
- 20. Anything else you need in your daily grooming and nightly sleeping activities.

PLEASE DON'T BRING:

Don't bring Magazines, weapons, knives, fireworks, matches, tobacco products. Etc. Again, please don't bring anything that doesn't honor God. If you can't figure it out, ask an adult. If they can't figure it out, don't bring it.

PLEASE DO REMEMBER:

You are an example to others. We are at camp to worship, praise and honor God.

Camp is an outreach to unsaved people.

You are to respect and listen to all adults.

Your fun should not be offensive to any around you.

Fun never includes doing something that might hurt, humiliate or damage! It's hard to pay attention to God's message when you're tired or a friend is distracting you during services.
